

Am I qualified to take the exam?

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ A citizen and permanent resident of the Philippines
- ✓ A graduate of any four-year Bachelor's degree course
- ✓ Has two years of work experience or further studies (or both)

The age limit has been removed.

FSOE has five phases:

1. Qualifying Test
2. Preliminary Interview
3. Written Test
4. Psychological Test
5. Oral Test

An average of 80% in the Written and Oral test is needed to pass the FSOE.

The FSOE in 5 parts

How do I apply for the FSOE?

Applicants must submit the following:

- Application form
- Civil Service Form No. 100
- Photocopy of college TOR
- Photocopy of college diploma or certificate of graduation
 - Proof of past or present employment or further studies
 - Photocopy of birth certificate from PSA
- Photocopy of Marriage Certificate (if applicable) and if married to a foreigner, authority to take the FSO Exams from the BFSE
 - Seven (7) pieces of photographs (4.5cm x 3.5cm) taken within three (3) months prior to filing of application
 - Copies of two valid IDs, with the original IDs to be presented upon submission
 - Php 500 admission fee
