- ✓ Soft copy of entry in .jpeg or .tiff format (burned on DVD-R)



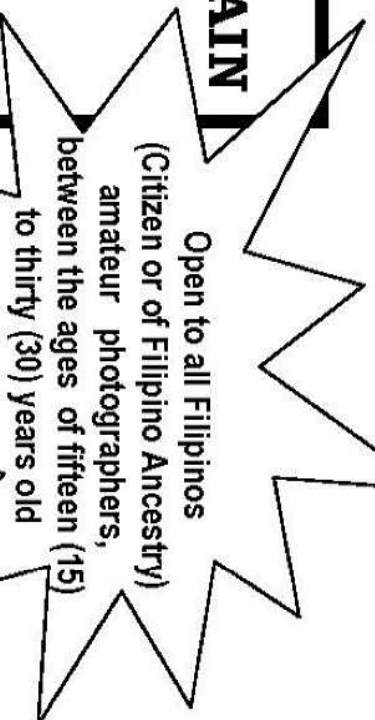

Maximum of three (3) entries / three pictures

All entries must be accompanied by an explanation of up to five (5) sentences maximum.

Entries exceeding maximum limit and incomplete entries will be automatically disqualified.

All entries must have been taken between 01 May and 15 June 2011



Entries must contain metadata as proof.

Photographs submitted for this contest must be unpublished and may not be submitted for subsequent photograph contests.

Participant must guarantee that the entries taken by him or her and ensure that no other entity has rights, claims or interests on the submitted photographs.

All entries must be free of watermarks and other markings. Entries should not contain any border.

Black and white color formats are accepted. Images should not contain drastic alterations. Elements should not be added nor removed. Color and contrast adjustments are acceptable. High Dynamic Range (HDR), Infra Red (IR) and Stitched Photos are not accepted.

All entries shall be treated as being free of restrictions and limitations on their use, reproduction, and publication. All photographs that will be used by the organizers in future events will be properly acknowledged.

All entries must portray an accurate reflection of the contest theme, without alternation (other than standard optimization, including removal or dust, cropping, adjustments to color and contrast, etc.)

Criteria:

- 40% Thematic Relevance
- 30% Originality
- 30% Technical Excellence
