ON FLIGHTS ALLOWED ENTRY TO THE PHILIPPINES

The Philippine Embassy informs the public that per Notice to Airman (NOTAM) released on 08 May 2020, by the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) Operations Center, inbound commercial flights carrying passengers will now be allowed to land at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) starting Monday, 11 May 2020, subject to the following conditions:

1. Inbound international chartered flights are allowed on Monday and Thursday provided that the necessary endorsement from the Department and clearance from CAAP are secured for purposes of securing slots at the NAIA; and
2. Scheduled inbound international commercial passenger flights are allowed on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday provided an approval is secured from CAAP forty-eight (48) hours before the scheduled departure from the airport of origin for purposes of securing slots at NAIA and rescheduling of flights if necessary. This requirement is in compliance with the 400 passengers per day capacity limitation.

These conditions, which will last one (1) month, from **11 May** to **10 June 2020**, will be implemented in NAIA only, with other international airports in the country having their separate restrictions.

The above conditions do not apply to the following:

1. En route flights experiencing emergencies;
2. Cargo flights;
3. Air ambulance and medical supplies flights;
4. Government and military flights;
5. Weather mitigation flights; and
6. Maintenance and utility flights.
