The Philippine Embassy in Madrid, Spain, as authorized by the Department of Foreign Affairs (MA-421-OFMS-2015), intends to re-cable the Embassy and install access points and secured WIFI connection with an Approved Budget Ceiling (ABC) of US Dollars Thirty-nine thousand three hundred sixty-five (US\$39,365.00). Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

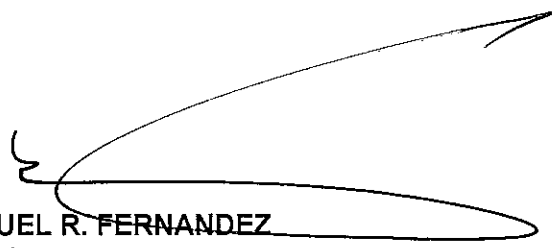
6. Bids must therefore be delivered to the address below on or before 23 November 2015, 12:00 noon. Late bids shall not be accepted.

Bid opening shall be on 23 November 2015, 3:00 p.m. at the Philippine Embassy in Madrid.

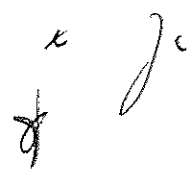
Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Anyone who wishes to observe the proceeding shall be most welcome.

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TERMS OF REFERENCE

I. Upgrading of Internet Connection

- Upgrade the Embassy's internet connection from ADSL to "Professional Line."
- Provide exclusive 50Mbps internet connection with at least 8 IP addresses.
- Each IP address should be able to accommodate at least 15 connections.

II. Structured Cabling of the Embassy

- Re-cabling of the entire building
- Provision of server box to allow centralized control and maintenance of the communications.

III. Provision of Secured WiFi access points

- Install WiFi access points covering the following areas:
 - a) Second Floor
 - b) Ground Floor
 - c) Basement
