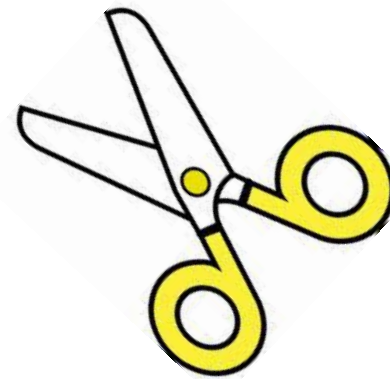


Contest Mechanics:

A. Participants

1. This contest is open to Filipino children in Spain and Andorra. Only one entry is allowed per participant.
2. There are two categories in this contest:
 - a. Children from 5 to 10 years may choose from these topics:
 - **Paggalang sa Nakatatanda at sa Kapwa**
 - **Kagandahang-Loob**
 - b. Children from 11 to 16 years may choose from these topics:
 - **Bayanihan**
 - **Pakikisama**

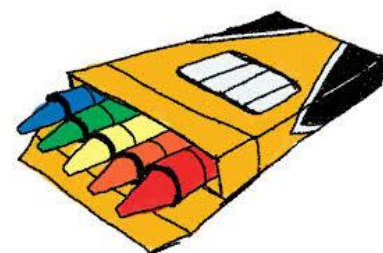


B. Duration

1. The contest is EXTENDED until 02 May 2016. Judging of entries will be from 3-6 May 2016.
2. The criteria for judging are the following:
Originality -35% Visual impact-35% Relevance to the theme-30%
3. Deadline of submission of entries is at 5PM on 02 May 2016.
4. Winners will be announced through the website of the Philippine Embassy in Madrid on the week of 09 May 2016.
5. The awarding ceremony will be held in June 2016 during the Barrio Fiesta in Madrid.

C. Prizes

1. Winners will receive the following cash prizes courtesy of the NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CULTURE AND THE ARTS (NCCA):
 - a. For 5 to 10 years old:
First Prize - €300
Second Prize - €200
Third Prize - €100
 - b. For 11 to 16 years old:
First Prize - €300
Second Prize - €200
Third Prize - €100
2. In addition, trophies or plaques and certificates of appreciation will also be given.
3. The best three competition entries in each age group will be featured in the website of the Philippine Embassy in Madrid (www.philembassymadrid.com).



D. Others

1. Drawings or paintings must adhere to the chosen topic
2. An entry can be a drawing using any media such as paint, pencil, pen, crayons, watercolor, cray pas or others. Use of mixed media is also allowed.
3. Entries may use any medium with the size of A3 (42 cm x 29.4 cm). Entries should have the following information at the back:
 - Name and age of the child
 - Proof of child's nationality (photocopy of Philippine passport/*permiso de residencia*, etc.)
 - Complete home address
 - Contact numbers
 - Chosen theme
4. Entries should be original. They should not have been published or submitted as an entry in another contest.
5. There should be no brand or company names used for the artwork.
6. All submitted entries shall become a property of the Philippine Embassy in Madrid. The Embassy reserves the right to keep the entries and use them as designs for greeting cards, posters or any communication material that it may wish to print or publish.
